


FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR DG0038 DOWNPIPE GRILLE FOR HONDA CB 500X 2019-

TOOLS REQUIRED


- 6 and 10mm spanners or sockets and wrench.
 - Set of metric Allen keys to include 2 & 4mm.
 - Small screwdriver.

GENERAL TORQUE SETTINGS

- M4 BOLT = 8Nm
- M5 BOLT = 12Nm
- M6 BOLT = 15Nm
- M8 BOLT = 20Nm
- M10 BOLT = 40Nm
- M12 BOLT = 40Nm



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place one of the M3 washers (item 8) onto each of the two M3 bolts (item 6) and place through the holes in the downpipe grille (item 1) as shown in picture 1 (please note you may have to carefully move the mesh strands slightly with a small screwdriver to allow the bolts to pass through the component).
- Place one of the M3 washers (item 8) and one of the M3 nyloc nuts (item 7) onto the exposed end of the right-hand bolt as shown in picture 2 then tighten the nut.
- Place the spring clip (item 5) onto the exposed end of the remaining bolt and secure in position using the remaining M3 washer (item 8) and M3 nyloc nut (item 7) and tighten the nut when in the correct position as shown in picture 2.
- Remove the horn nut arrowed in **picture 3** and remove the horn.
- Remove the two original bolts in positions arrowed in **pictures 4 and 5**.
- Carefully ease the radiator surround away from the radiator and offer the downpipe grille into position, then secure in position using the two M6 bolts (item 2) with washers (item 3) as shown in pictures 4 and 5.
- Use the remaining M6 washers (**item 3**) and M6 nyloc nuts (**item 4**) to lock the bolts in position as shown in **pictures 6 and 7** ensuring the spring clip is located over the exhaust as shown in **picture 8**.Refit the horn as original.
